Before the modern age and worldwide spread of knowledge, written examples of new mathematical developments have come to light only in a few locales. Tartaglia discovered solutions for cubic equations. Initially, game theory addressed two-person zero-sum games, in which a participant's gains or losses are exactly balanced by the losses and gains of the other participant. The use of game theory in the social sciences has expanded, and game theory has been Game theory is the study of mathematical models of strategic interactions. In the 1950s, it was extended to the study of non zero-sum games, and was eventually applied to a wide range of behavioral relations. It has applications in many fields of social science, and is used extensively in economics, logic, systems science and computer science. In contrast, a heuristic is an approach to solving problems without well-defined correct or optimal results.
