Ghislandi was introduced to the public as a ventriloquist, when, with his dummy Sergio, he became a finalist in the 1986/87 edition of the RaiUno program Fantastico 7. In 1987, he played a gay recruit in Soldati – 365 all’alba. Thanks to his expressive skills and surreal style of acting, Ghislandi was often asked to play roles as a character actor, working both in the cinema and on television.
