Also attached to the frame are the fuel tank and battery. It supports the engine, provides a location for the steering and rear suspension, and supports the rider and any passenger or luggage. At the front of the frame is found the steering head tube that holds the pivoting front fork, while at the rear there is a pivot point for the swingarm suspension motion. Some motorcycles include the engine as a load-bearing stressed member; while some other bikes do not use a single frame, but instead have a front and a rear subframe attached to the engine
