Elvin A. Medical laboratory scientist To this end, much of the work done by medical laboratory scientists involves ensuring specimen quality, interpreting test results, data-logging, testing control products, performing calibration. The Medical Technologist is tasked with releasing the patient results to aid in further treatment. The utility of clinical diagnostic testing relies squarely on the validity of test methodology.
