Condensed matter physics More generally, the subject deals with condensed phases of matter: systems of many constituents with strong interactions among them. Condensed matter physicists seek to understand the behavior of these phases by experiments to measure various material properties. More exotic condensed phases include the superconducting phase exhibited by certain materials at extremely low cryogenic temperatures, the ferromagnetic and antiferromagnetic phases of spins on crystal lattices of atoms, the Bose-Einstein condensates found in ultracold atomic systems, and liquid crystals.
