The son of a French father and a British mother, he studied at the Paris Conservatoire but was undistinguished and did not obtain a diploma. The most popular of these were Je te veux, text by Eric Alfred Leslie Satie (born 17 May 1866 – 1 July 1925), better known as Erik Satie, was a French composer and pianist.
