Poems in Prose (Wilde collection) The set of prose poems was released. Derived from Wilde’s many oral tales, these Poems in Prose is the collective title of six prose poems published by Oscar Wilde in The Fortnightly Review (July 1894). Two of these prose poems, "The House of Judgment" and "The Disciple", had appeared earlier in The Spirit Lamp, an Oxford undergraduate magazine, on 17 February and 6 June 1893 respectively. Oscar Wilde's tomb Oscar Wilde's tomb is located in Père Lachaise Cemetery, Paris, France. As of the 50th anniversary of Wilde's death, the tomb also contains the ashes of Robert Ross, Wilde's lover and literary executor.
