Green Day Green Day is an American rock band formed in Rodeo, California, in 1987 by lead singer and guitarist Billie Joe Armstrong and bassist and backing vocalist Mike Dirnt, with drummer Tré Cool joining in 1990. Green Day's seventh album, a rock opera called *American Idiot* (2004), found popularity with a younger generation and sold six million copies in the US. Green Day has been credited with reigniting mainstream interest in punk rock. In 1994, their major-label debut *Dookie*, released through Reprise Records, became a breakout success and eventually shipped over 20 million copies in the United States

 The franchise originated in a series of video games developed by BioWare and originally published by Microsoft Game Studios on the first two games and its expansions. Later on, the series was taken over by Electronic Arts through its acquisition of BioWare. Each installment is a third-person shooter with role-playing elements. The first three games form a trilogy in which the player character, Commander Shepard, attempts to save the Milky Way galaxy from a race of ancient, hibernating machines known as the Reapers. The inaugural video game in the series, Mass Effect (2007), follows Shepard's investigation of Saren Arterius, one of the Reapers' agents. In 1986 the trilogy won the Prometheus Hall of Fame Award.
