BMW M5 BMW called it the First Edition M5 and oddly enough they were produced The BMW M5 is a super high-performance variant of the BMW 5 Series marketed under the BMW M sub-brand. The M5 has always been produced in the saloon (sedan, US English) body style, but in some countries the M5 has also been available as an estate/touring (wagon, US English) from 1992 to 1995, from 2006 to 2010, and since 2024

The Z4 (E89) was succeeded by the Z4 (G29) in 2018. The first M5 model was hand-built beginning in late 1984 on the E28 535i chassis with a modified engine from the M1 that made it the fastest production saloon at the time. M5 models have been produced for every generation of the 5 Series since 1984, with occasional gaps in production (1995 to 1998, 2023 to 2024). The E60 generation introduced various new electronic features, including the iDrive infotainment system, head-up display, active cruise control, active steering, adaptive headlights, night vision, lane departure warning and voice control. The E60 was the first 5 Series to be available with a turbocharged petrol engine, a 6-speed automatic transmission and regenerative braking. that there were no longer separate roadster and coupé versions of the car. There was no Z4 M model for the E89 generation.

BMW X5 The X5 made its debut in 1999 as the E53 model. It debuted in July 2006 for the 2007 model year. The E70 featured the torque-split capable xDrive all-wheel drive system mated to an automatic gearbox. The second generation featured key improvements, including BMW's iDrive system as standard across The BMW X5 is a mid-size luxury crossover SUV produced by BMW. It was BMW's first SUV. At launch, it featured all-wheel drive and was available with either a manual or automatic gearbox. X5. In 2009, the X5 M performance variant was released as a 2010 model. The second generation was launched in 2006, and was known internally as the E70

The M6 model was introduced in 2005 in coupé and convertible body styles. It is powered by the S85 V10 engine shared with the E60 M5, and most M6s were produced with a 7-speed automated manual transmission ("SMG III"). In March 2011, the BMW 6

Series (F06/F12/F13) began production as the successor to the E63. The initial model was available in a coupé body style, with a convertible body style made available soon after. M3 saloons were offered initially during the E36 (1994–1999) and E90 (2008–2012) generations. Since 2014, the coupé and convertible models have been rebranded as the 4 Series range, making the high-performance variant the M4. Variants of the 3 Series since then have seen the M3 produced as a saloon, until 2020, when the M3 was produced as an estate (Touring) for the first time, alongside the saloon variant. In late... BMW 5 Series Each successive generation has been given an internal G-code designation since 2017. It is the successor to the BMW New Class sedans and is currently in its eighth generation. Previously, a F-code designation was used between 2010 and 2016, while an E-code designation was used between 1972 and 2010. The BMW 5 Series is an executive car manufactured and marketed by BMW since 1972. A 5-door fastback (marketed as "Gran Turismo") was sold between 2009 and 2017. The car is sold as either a sedan or, since 1991, a station wagon (marketed as "Touring"). It is the successor to the BMW New Class sedans and is currently in its The BMW 5 Series is an executive car manufactured and marketed by BMW since 1972. BMW 3 Series (E90) turbocharged petrol engine. The model was introduced in December 2004, and produced by BMW until October 2013 and is often collectively referred to as the E90, E9x, or occasionally, the E92. It was also the first 3 Series to include the iDrive operating system, which consists of navigation, infotainment and essential The fifth generation of the BMW 3 Series range of compact executive cars is designated under the model codes E90 (saloon), E91 (estate, marketed as 'Touring'), E92 (coupé) and E93 (convertible)

BMW X5 (E70) S. The E65 was the first BMW vehicle to include the iDrive infotainment system, and the exterior styling (overseen by Chris Bangle) marked a significant departure from traditional BMW styling. Other new features included active anti-roll bars, a six-speed automatic transmission, an electronic Smart Key (dispensing with the traditional metallic key), and night vision. The 760i model also utilised the world's first production V12 engine to use direct injection. The E89 Z4 was the first Z Series model to use a retractable hardtop roof, which meant

BMW Z4 (E89) ordered with the iDrive infotainment system with BMWConnected services and keyless entry. The E63 uses a shortened version of the E60 5 Series chassis and subsequently shares many features. The car initially drew criticism, due to its controversial styling and complicated iDrive system. b80efce1c2

BMW 7 Series (E65) The E65 was the first BMW vehicle to include the iDrive infotainment system, and the exterior styling (overseen by The fourth generation of the BMW 7 Series consists of the BMW E65 and BMW E66 luxury cars. The E65/E66 was produced from 2001 to 2008 and is often collectively referred to as the E65. The E92 335i was the first 3 Series model produced with a turbocharged petrol engine. It was also the first 3 Series to include the iDrive operating system, which consists of navigation, infotainment and essential vehicle functions. The E9x saw the introduction of run-flat tyres to the 3 Series range. Models with run-flat tires are not equipped with a spare tyre. b80efce1c2 BMW marketed the X5 officially as a "Sports Activity Vehicle" (SAV), rather than an SUV, to indicate its on-road handling capability despite its large dimensions. The X5 signaled a shift away from the utilisation of body-on-frame construction, in favour of more modern monocoque chassis construction. Although the... b80efce1c2
