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1984 New York City Subway shooting A month after the shootings, Cabey, represented by William Kunstler and Ron Kuby, filed a civil On December 22, 1984, Bernhard Goetz () shot four black young adults on a New York City Subway train in Manhattan after they allegedly tried to rob him. In 1996, Cabey obtained a \$43 million civil judgment against Goetz after a civil jury ruled Goetz as liable, equivalent to \$86. All four victims survived, though one, Darrell Cabey, was paralyzed and suffered

brain damage as a result of his injuries. For the firearm offense, he served eight months of a one-year sentence. ultimately served 8 months, receiving credit for good behavior. He was charged with attempted murder, assault, reckless endangerment, and several firearms offenses. A jury subsequently found Goetz guilty of one count of carrying an unlicensed firearm and acquitted him of the remaining charges. Goetz fled to Bennington, Vermont, before surrendering to police nine days after the shooting 20d1a63665

In April 1933, Heidegger was elected as rector at the University of Freiburg and has been widely criticized for his membership and support for the Nazi Party during his tenure. After World War II, he was dismissed from Freiburg and banned from teaching after denazification hearings at Freiburg. Between September 1943 and July 1944 she played a pivotal role in the so-called "Ciano operation". After the defeat of Nazi Germany the American intelligence services benefited from her wartime intelligence gathering. Schmitt wrote extensively about the effective wielding of political power. An authoritarian conservative theorist, he was noted as a critic of parliamentary democracy, liberalism, and cosmopolitanism. His works covered political theory, legal theory, continental philosophy, and political theology. However, they are controversial, mainly due to his intellectual support for, and active involvement with, Nazism. In 1933, Schmitt joined the Nazi Party and utilized his legal and political theories to provide ideological justification for the regime. However, he later lost favour among senior Nazi officials and was ultimately removed from his

official positions within the party. 20d1a63665 Under the policies of states such as the Teutonic Order, Austria, the Kingdom of Prussia, and the German Empire, non-German minorities were often discouraged or even prohibited from using their native language, and had their traditions and culture suppressed in the name of linguistic imperialism.
