History of soil science These chemists held the "balance-sheet" theory of plant nutrition. This concept still has value when applied within the framework of modern soil science, although a useful understanding of soils goes beyond the removal of nutrients from soil by harvested crops and their return in manure, lime, and fertilizer. Soil was considered a more or less static storage bin for plant nutrients—the soils could be used and replaced. The soils were rarely examined below the depth of normal tillage. Dissection Consequently, dissection is typically conducted in a morgue or in an anatomy lab. Less extensive dissection of plants and smaller animals preserved in a formaldehyde solution is typically carried out or demonstrated in biology and natural science classes in middle school and high school, while extensive dissections of cadavers of adults and children, both fresh and preserved are carried out by medical students in medical schools as a part of the teaching in subjects such as anatomy, pathology and forensic medicine.
