Muriel, No. 121,590, was a wooden screw steamer of 59 tons gross and 22 tons net register. The trawler had a length of 64.7 feet (19.7 m), a beam of 16.2 feet (4.9 m), and a depth of 8 feet (2.4 m). Muriel's engines were rated at 18 horsepower (13 kW). Muriel was owned by P Feron & Sons and commanded by Captain William Stephen, who had been master of the vessel since 1929.
