The price elasticity gives the percentage change in quantity demanded when

there is a one percent increase in price, holding everything else constant. If the elasticity is -2 , that means a one percent price rise leads to a two percent decline in quantity demanded. Other elasticities measure how the quantity demanded changes with other variables (e.g. the income elasticity of demand for consumer income changes).

Sample size determination In experimental design, where a study may be divided into different treatment. If a reasonable estimate for p is known the quantity $p(1-p)$ may be used in place of 0. As the Sample size determination or estimation is the act of choosing the number of observations or replicates to include in a statistical sample. The sample size is an important feature of any empirical study in which the goal is to make inferences about a population from a sample. In practice, the sample size used in a study is usually determined based on the cost, time, or convenience of collecting the data, and the need for it to offer sufficient statistical power. In complex studies, different sample sizes may be allocated, such as in stratified surveys or experimental designs with multiple treatment groups. for sample size assessments. In a census, data is sought for an entire population, hence the intended sample size is equal to the population.
