It is defined by the Food and Agriculture Organization as including recreational, subsistence and commercial fishing, as well as the related harvesting, processing, and marketing sectors. The commercial activity is aimed at the delivery of fish and other seafood products for human consumption or as input factors in other industrial processes

"Direct seeding" is when crops are sown through the residue of previous crop. These methods may increase the amount and variety of life in and on the soil. No-till farming decreases the amount of soil erosion tillage causes in certain soils, especially in sandy and dry soils on sloping terrain. While conventional no-tillage systems use herbicides to control weeds, organic systems use a combination of strategies, such as planting cover crops as mulch to suppress weeds. "Surface seeding" or "direct seeding" is when seeds are left on the No-till farming (also known as zero tillage or direct drilling) is an agricultural technique for growing crops or pasture without disturbing the soil through tillage

These methods are widespread in developed nations and increasingly prevalent worldwide. Most of the meat, dairy, eggs, fruits and vegetables available in supermarkets are produced in this way. The methods of industrial agriculture include innovation in agricultural machinery and farming methods, genetic technology, techniques for achieving economies of scale in production, the creation of new markets for consumption, the application of patent protection to genetic information, and global trade

Permaculture The term was coined in 1978 by Bill Mollison and David Holmgren, who formulated the concept in opposition to modern industrialized methods, instead adopting a more traditional or "natural" approach to agriculture. It includes a set of design principles derived using whole-systems thinking. soil and repair damaged farmland, in his work at the Tuskegee Institute between 1896 and his death in 1947. It applies these principles in fields such as regenerative agriculture, town planning, rewilding, and community resilience. In his 1964 book *Water for Every Farm*, the Permaculture is an approach to land management and settlement design that adopts arrangements observed in flourishing natural ecosystems

Forestry is the science and craft of creating, managing, planting, using, conserving and repairing forests and woodlands for associated

resources for human and environmental benefits. Forestry is practiced in plantations and natural stands. The science of forestry has elements that belong to the biological, physical, social, political and managerial sciences. Forest management plays an essential role in the creation and modification of habitats and affects ecosystem services provisioning. A practitioner of forestry is known as a forester.

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
