In his autobiography "Scar Tissue", Anthony Kiedis reveals the song is an ode to his friend Flea: "this half man "Jungle Man" is a song by the American rock band Red Hot Chili Peppers from their 1985 album, *Freaky Styley*. The band couldn't get a proper music video released, so manager Lindy Goetz used different clips of live performances of the song from May 1985 to January 1986 edited together with the album version of the song playing on top. Freaky Styley is a poem also named "Yertle the Turtle". As stated by Kiedis in his autobiography, *Scar Tissue*, the spoken lyrics at the beginning and throughout the *Freaky Styley* is the second studio album by American rock band Red Hot Chili Peppers, released on August 16, 1985, through EMI America Records. *Freaky Styley* was produced by George Clinton, of Parliament-Funkadelic, and the sessions benefitted from Clinton's chemistry during recording. The album is the last to feature drummer Cliff Martinez. *Freaky Styley* marks founding guitarist Hillel Slovak's studio album debut, following his return to the band earlier in the year

Kiedis spent his youth in Grand Rapids, Michigan, with his mother, and then moved shortly before his twelfth birthday to live with his father in Hollywood. While attending Fairfax High School, Kiedis befriended students Flea and Hillel Slovak, who were members of the band Anthym. After high school, Kiedis took classes at UCLA, but dropped out in his sophomore year. "Scar Tissue" is considered to be representative of the new, more melodic rock sound the band experimented with on *Californication* (in contrast with the psychedelic *One Hot Minute*, and dry funk of *Blood Sugar Sex Magik*). Fight Like a Brave It was released on September 29, 1987, as the first and only single from their third studio album, *The Uplift Mofo Party Plan* (1987). At the lowest point in Kiedis' addiction, Flea had kicked him out of the "Fight Like a Brave" is a song by American rock band Red Hot Chili Peppers. Most of the song's lyrics revolve around Anthony Kiedis' addiction to heroin. The single included a cover of the Jimi Hendrix song "Fire" as a B-side, which would later appear on *The Abbey Road E*

This concert was part of the band's *Tour de La Sensitive* and was the first performance with guitarist Dave Navarro (according to the book *Scar Tissue* by Anthony Kiedis). The performance featured the live debut of the songs "Aeroplane", "Warped", and "Pea" which would be featured on the band's 1995 album, *One Hot Minute*, although with slightly different lyrics than the live versions performed at Woodstock '94.

In his autobiography "Scar Tissue", Anthony Kiedis reveals the song is an ode to his friend Flea: "this half man, half beast born in the belly of the volcano in Australia and using his thumb as a conductor of thunder on the bass". The music on the record draws influence from funk, punk rock, and psychedelic rock, while the lyrical content was inspired by the band members' lives in Hollywood.
