Assisted suicide in the United Kingdom In England and Wales, the Suicide Act 1961 prohibits "aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring suicide" with a penalty of up to 14 years' imprisonment. Bills to legalise assisted dying have been introduced multiple Assisted suicide is the ending of one's own life with the assistance of another. when used in the context of a medically assisted suicide for the purpose of relieving suffering. Following legal challenges, public prosecutorial guidance was issued in 2010 indicating scenarios where prosecution for assisted suicide may not be in the public interest. The phrase "assisted dying" is often used instead of physician-assisted suicide by proponents of legalisation and the media when used in the context of a medically assisted suicide for the purpose of relieving suffering. Approximately 46 Britons a year travel abroad for physician-assisted suicide, usually to Dignitas in Switzerland. It is currently illegal under the laws of the United Kingdom 3155002aa6

Assisted living The term is popular in the United States. Still, the setting is similar to a retirement home, in the sense that facilities provide a group living environment and typically cater to an older adult population. describe what proponents refer to as "medical aid in dying" (MAID), in which a terminally ill adult is prescribed, and self-administers, barbiturates if they feel that they are suffering significantly. interchangeably with "physician-assisted suicide" (PAS), "physician-assisted dying", "physician-assisted death", and "assisted death". This practice is strictly regulated by the laws and rules of the state or country that a person lives in. The physician's assistance is usually limited to writing a prescription for a lethal dose of drugs. This practice falls under the concept of the medical right to die (i.e. the right of a person to choose when and how they will die, either through medical aid in dying or refusing life-saving medical treatment). 3155002aa6 Assisted suicide is similar to, but distinct from, euthanasia (sometimes called "mercy killing").
