The awards have had several previous names, owners and sponsors since being launched in 1990, including the National Book Awards from 2010 to 2014 5a4bf830b2

The British Book Awards ran from 1990 to 2009 and were founded by the editor of Publishing News. The awards were then acquired by Agile Marketing, which renamed them the National Book Awards and called them the Galaxy National Book Awards (2010–2011) and later the Specsavers National Book Awards (2012–2014) after their headline sponsors. There were no National Book Awards after 2014; in 2017 the awards were acquired by The Bookseller from the estate of Publishing News' founder, Fred Newman, and renamed back to The British Book Awards or the Nibbies. 5a4bf830b2 Walliams wrote and starred in the BBC sitcom *Big School* (2013–2014). In 2015, he starred as Tommy Beresford in the BBC drama series *Partners in Crime*, and wrote and starred in the BBC sketch comedy series *Walliams & Friend*. He has received multiple National Television Awards for his work on *Britain's Got Talent*. Walliams was appointed Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE) in the 2017 Birthday Honours for services to charity and the arts. == Plot == Walliams began writing children's novels in 2008 after securing a contract with the publisher HarperCollins. His books have been translated into 53 languages, and he has been described as "the fastest-growing children's author in the UK", with a literary style compared to that of Roald Dahl. Some of his books have been adapted into television films, which he has also appeared in, including Mr Stink (2012), Gangsta Granny (2013), The Boy in the Dress (2014), Billionaire Boy (2016), Ratburger (2017), Grandpa's Great Escape (2018), The Midnight Gang (also 2018) and Gangsta Granny Strikes Again! (2022). A couple of years prior, Zoe's father bought Zoe a hamster as a birthday present, and she named it Gingernut. Once Sheila moved in, she wanted the hamster out. Zoe taught it tricks and had ambitions to be a famous animal trainer, but the hamster dies in suspicious circumstances. Zoe is a young girl whose mother died when she was a baby. Zoe's father lost his job at an ice cream factory and he and Zoe now live in

a council flat with her large stepmother, Sheila, living off scant benefit money from the government. Zoe's father spends much of his time at a local pub, as he is depressed because he has lost his job. Sheila loves prawn cocktail crisps and cigarettes, and is so lazy she asks Zoe to pick her nose for her. Zoe is bullied daily by a classmate named Tina Trotts. 5a4bf830b2 Ben, an 11-year old, curious boy, hates having to stay with his old Granny every Friday because his parents go to see a dancing show named Strictly Stars Dancing which is a parody of Strictly Come Dancing.
