The shells of dead diatoms are a significant component of marine sediment, and the entire Amazon basin is fertilized annually by 27 million tons of diatom shell dust transported by transatlantic winds from the African Sahara, much of it from the Bodélé Depression, which was once made up of a system of fresh-water. They generate about 20 to 50 percent of the oxygen produced on the planet each year, take in over 6. Living diatoms make up a significant portion of Earth's biomass. 7 billion tonnes of silicon each year from the waters in which they live, and constitute nearly half of the organic material found in the oceans 6f10d5a574
