There are language conservation and revitalization efforts taking place in San Mateo Ixtatán Chuj (Spanish: [tʃux]) is a Mayan language spoken by around 40,000 members of the Chuj people in Guatemala and around 3,000 members in Mexico. The two main dialects of Chuj are the San Mateo Ixtatán dialect and the San Sebastián Coatán dialect. The Chujean branch emerged approximately 2,000 years ago.
