Trim levels The Toyota Avensis (Japanese: トヨタアベンシス, Hepburn: Toyota Abenshisu) is a mid-size/large family car built in Derbyshire, United Kingdom by the Japanese automaker Toyota from October 1997 to August 2018. Following the withdrawal of the Camry in 2004 (2005 in Switzerland), the Avensis became the largest Toyota saloon sold in Western Europe. It was the direct successor to the European Carina E and was available as a four-door saloon, five-door liftback and estate 6f751459ff

Having previously

In most export markets, Toyota marketed the vehicle as the Toyota Cressida between 1976 and 1992 across four generations.
