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Hecate 128: Berg comments on Hecate's endorsement of Roman hegemony in her representation Hecate ( HEK-ə-tee; Ancient Greek: Ἑκάτη) is a goddess in ancient Greek religion and mythology, most often shown holding a pair of torches, a key, or snakes, or accompanied by dogs, and in later periods depicted as three-formed or triple-bodied. She had popular followings amongst the witches of Thessaly, and an important sanctuary among the Carians of Asia Minor in Lagina. pronounced [hekáta:]; Latin: Hecatē ['hɛkate:] or Hecata ['hɛkata]. The earliest evidence for Hecate's cult comes from Selinunte, in Sicily. She is variously associated with crossroads, night, light, magic, witchcraft, drugs, and the Moon. Berg 1974, p. Her earliest appearance in literature was in Hesiod's Theogony in the 8th century BCE as a goddess of great honour with domains in sky, earth, and sea c407b19970

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
