Dog coat genetics Dogs have about 19,000 genes in their genome but only a handful affect the physical variations in their coats. In any one gene locus a dog will either be homozygous where the gene is made of two identical alleles (one from its mother and one its father) or heterozygous where the gene is made of two different alleles (one inherited from each parent). Usually only one or a small number of alleles exist for each gene.
