Interactive proof system Messages are sent between the verifier and prover until the verifier has an answer to the problem and has "convinced" itself that it is correct. machine. The main complexity classes describing interactive proof systems are AM and IP. The parties interact by exchanging messages in order to ascertain whether a given string belongs to a language or not. The prover is assumed to possess unlimited computational resources but cannot be trusted, while the verifier has bounded computation power but is assumed to be always honest.
