that the extraction result goes beyond the creation of structured information or the transformation into a relational schema. It requires either the reuse of existing formal knowledge (reusing identifiers or ontologies) or the generation of a schema based on the source data. The resulting knowledge needs to be in a machine-readable and machine-interpretable format and must represent knowledge in a manner that facilitates inferencing. More elaborate methods are employing heuristics or learning algorithms to induce schematic information (methods overlap with ontology learning) Knowledge extraction is the creation of knowledge from structured (relational databases, XML) and unstructured (text, documents, images) sources d0edd12a29
