The format was the same as on the British show, and the 15 incremental prize amounts had the same numeric values, from 100 up to 1,000,000. Initially the series aired on Friday and Tuesday night, with the Tuesday night episode split between an episode of the Irish soap opera Fair City. The show had Who Wants to Be a Millionaire. is the Irish version of the British quiz show Who Wants to Be a Millionaire.
