Witchcraft (Book of Love song) The B-side "Enchantra" is a completely different composition "Witchcraft" is the seventh single released by the American synthpop band Book of Love. The 12" single includes samples from the track "Let's All Chant" by Michael Zager Band. The song was the third, and final single from the band's second album Lullaby, and was released on July 15, 1989

Dancin' and Lovin' This album comes after a long-time association with producer Thom Bell and marks a shift to disco, resulting in a commercial success after a short string of decline. The opening track and lead single from the group's eponymous LP, "Let's All Chant" was released as a single in December 1977, with the track "Love Express" as a B-side. An unexpected smash hit, the single reached number one on the disco chart and crossed over to the Soul Singles chart, where it peaked at...

White Witch (album) White Witch wasn't a commercial success and failed to enter any sales charts. "You Got Me Dancing" and "What's Your Name, What's Your Number". The album spawned two moderate hit singles: "N. Y. White Witch is the second studio album by the group Andrea True Connection, released in 1977 by Buddah Records. The first single from the album was "N. Y. Kiss guitarist Bruce Kulick. The material was co-produced by the disco pioneers Michael Zager and Jerry Love. It was the last album released by the group, and the vocalist Andrea True would later release only one solo album in 1980

The EP is extended dance mixes of "Somebody Should Have Told Me", "An Umbrella Song" and Houston's Billboard Dance chart hit single "Think It Over", which peaked at #5 and Billboards Hot Soul chart at #32, also included is the self-titled track, "Warning - Danger". "Witchcraft" was the only single from the album Lullaby that failed to make the Billboard charts. The track samples the classic 60s TV series Bewitched, and also chants the names of the witches/characters from the show... "Enchantra, Endora,

Tabitha, Esmerelda, Clara, Hagatha". The song features quirky deadpan rap-style vocals from Susan Ottaviano, Jade Lee, and Lauren Roselli, with a Shakespeare-inspired incanting of ingredients for brewing a love potion.
