Salman Rushdie knighthood controversy Soon after the news of the knighthood was released protests against the honour were held in Malaysia and in Pakistan where effigies of the writer were publicly burnt. When asked by the Associated Press if his silence was at the request of the British government, Rushdie replied by e-mail stating. On 19 June 2007, governments in both Pakistan and Iran summoned their British ambassadors to officially protest against the award. The affair had a notable impact on geopolitics when, in 1989, Ruhollah Khomeini, Supreme Leader of Iran, issued a fatwa ordering Muslims to kill Rushdie.
