Harris was later made director-general of highways in the Ministry of Transport during which time he was responsible for the construction of the 650 miles of motorway, a focus on ground investigation at pre-tender stage and the development of new motorway signalling. 31 May 1963. 4795. Highway dimension It was first formally defined by Abraham et al. that any road network has a sparse set of "transit nodes", such that driving from a point A to a sufficiently far away point B along the shortest route will always pass through one of these transit nodes. The highway dimension is a graph parameter modelling transportation networks, such as road networks or public transportation networks. This relates to the spoke-hub distribution paradigm in transport topology optimization.
