Gregor Mendel Though farmers had known for millennia that crossbreeding of animals and plants could favor certain desirable traits, Mendel's pea plant experiments conducted between 1856 and 1863 established many of the rules of heredity, now referred to as the laws of Mendelian inheritance. By watching the development of flies in which the earliest cell division produced two different genomes, he measured the embryonic distance between organs in a unit which is called the sturt in his honor. In 1865, Gregor Mendel published a paper entitled "Experiments in Plant Hybridization," in which he proposed the principles of heredity. Throughout his career he worked on the organism *Drosophila melanogaster* with Thomas Hunt Morgan. Johnson.
