Unified State Exam The USE in Russian language and mathematics is obligatory; that means that every student must achieve the necessary results in these subjects to enter any Russian university or obtain a high school diploma. It serves as a form of State Final Certification (GIA) for educational programs of secondary general education. Since 2015 the mathematics exam has been divided into two levels: Basic The Unified State Exam (Russian: Единый государственный экзамен, ЕГЭ, Yedinyy gosudarstvennyy ekzamen, YeGE) is a series of mandatory, centralized examinations conducted across the Russian Federation in secondary educational institutions, such as schools, lyceums, and gymnasiums. The USE simultaneously acts as both a school graduation examination and an entrance examination for higher education institutions, ensuring that students meet standardized educational requirements. Leaving Certificate (Ireland) Examination papers, including English, Mathematics and Physics were The Leaving Certificate Examination (Irish: Scrúdú na hArdteistiméireachta), commonly referred to as the Leaving Cert or (informally) the Leaving (Irish: Ardteist), is the final exam of the Irish secondary school system and the university matriculation examination in Ireland. Most students taking the examination are aged 16–19; in excess of eighty percent of this group undertake the exam. On 12 June 1969, exam papers were stolen in a break-in to a Dublin secondary school. It takes a minimum of two years' preparation, but an optional Transition Year means that for those students it takes place three years after the Junior Cycle examination. The Leaving Certificate Examinations are taken annually by approximately 60,000 students. These years are referred to collectively as the "Senior Cycle".
