Propositional logic from some other sentence or group of sentences. Some sources include other connectives, as in the table below. Compound propositions are formed by connecting propositions by logical connectives representing the truth functions of conjunction, disjunction, implication, biconditional, and negation. It deals with propositions (which can be true or false) and relations between propositions, including the construction of arguments based on them. Propositional logic deals with statements, which are defined as declarative sentences having truth value Propositional logic is a branch of logic. It is also called statement logic, sentential calculus, propositional calculus, sentential logic, or sometimes zeroth-order logic. Sometimes, it is called first-order propositional logic to contrast it with System F, but it should not be confused with first-order logic

On the Origin of Species generate variation. Darwin included evidence that he had collected on the Beagle expedition in the 1830s and his subsequent findings from research, correspondence. Darwin's book introduced the scientific theory that populations evolve over the course of generations through a process of natural selection, although Lamarckism was also included as a mechanism of lesser importance. The book presented a body of evidence that the diversity of life arose by common descent through a branching pattern of evolution. The opening two sentences of On The Origin demonstrate this point and also show that Darwin did not see the role of natural selection On the Origin of Species (or, more completely, On the Origin of Species by Means of Natural Selection, or the Preservation of Favoured Races in the Struggle for Life) is a work of scientific literature by Charles Darwin that is considered to be the foundation of evolutionary biology. It was published on 24 November 1859

Mental chronometry Reaction time (RT; also referred to as "response time") is measured by the elapsed time between stimulus onset and an individual's response on elementary cognitive tasks (ECTs), which are relatively simple perceptual-motor tasks typically administered in a laboratory setting. Mental chronometry is one of the core methodological paradigms of human experimental, cognitive, and differential psychology, but is also commonly analyzed in psychophysiology, cognitive neuroscience, and behavioral neuroscience to help elucidate the biological mechanisms underlying perception, attention, and decision-making in humans and other. multi-choice RT paradigms exemplifies the much-replicated finding that this association is largely mediated by the number of choices available in the task Mental chronometry is the scientific study of processing speed or reaction time on cognitive tasks to infer the content, duration, and temporal sequencing of mental operations

Gödel's incompleteness theorems The theorems are interpreted as showing that Hilbert's program to find a complete and consistent set of axioms for all mathematics is impossible. Thus, although the Gödel sentence refers indirectly to sentences of the system F, when read as Gödel's incompleteness theorems are two theorems of mathematical logic that are concerned with the limits of provability in formal axiomatic theories. These results, published by Kurt Gödel in 1931, are important both in mathematical logic and in the philosophy of mathematics. would be decidable by the system if it were complete

BERT (language model) It learns to represent text as a sequence of vectors using self-supervised learning. sentence logically follows another. until dead", and the penalty is imposed only in the 'rarest of cases'. nearly 65% of the death sentences were commuted to life sentences. Executions are carried out by hanging as the primary method of execution

Liar paradox It is still generally called the "liar paradox" although abstraction is made precisely from the liar making the statement. Trying to assign to this statement, the strengthened liar, a classical binary truth value leads to a contradiction. If the liar is indeed lying, then the liar is telling the truth, which means the liar just lied. the referring sentence is considered to be a part of a 'meta-language' with respect to the object language. In "this sentence is a lie", the paradox is strengthened in order to make it amenable to more rigorous logical analysis. It is legitimate for sentences in 'languages' In philosophy and logic, the classical liar paradox or liar's paradox or antinomy of the liar is the statement of a liar that they are lying: for instance, declaring that "I am lying"

BERT is trained by masked token prediction and next sentence prediction. As a result of this training process, BERT learns contextual, latent representations of tokens in their context, similar to ELMo and GPT-2. It found applications for many natural language processing tasks, such as coreference resolution and polysemy resolution. It is an evolutionary step... Code-switching is different from plurilingualism in that plurilingualism refers to the ability of an individual to use multiple languages, while code-switching is the act of using multiple languages together. Multilinguals (speakers of more than one language) sometimes use elements of multiple languages when conversing with each other. Thus, code-switching is the use of more than one linguistic variety in a manner...
