Pseudoscience many unsolved problems; but the community of practitioners makes little attempt to develop the theory towards solutions of the problems, shows no concern Pseudoscience consists of statements, beliefs, or practices that claim to be both scientific and factual but are incompatible with the scientific method. Pseudoscience is often characterized by contradictory, exaggerated or unfalsifiable claims; reliance on confirmation bias rather than rigorous attempts at refutation; lack of openness to evaluation by other experts; absence of systematic practices when

developing hypotheses; and continued adherence long after the pseudoscientific hypotheses have been experimentally discredited. It is not the same as junk science

Intelligence quotient This results in approximately two-thirds of the population scoring between IQ 85 and IQ 115 and about 2 percent each above 130 and below 70. For modern IQ tests, the raw score is transformed to a normal distribution with mean 100 and standard deviation 15. Originally, IQ was a score obtained by dividing a person's estimated mental age, obtained by administering an intelligence test, by the

person's chronological age. was popular in the 1970s and early 1980s, but faded owing to both practical problems and theoretical criticisms. The resulting fraction (quotient) was multiplied by 100 to obtain the IQ score.
