Bloody Sunday (1972) Thirteen men were killed outright and the death of another man four months later was attributed to gunshot injuries from the incident. The soldiers were from the 1st Battalion of the Parachute. Many of the victims were shot while fleeing from the soldiers, and some were shot while trying to help the wounded. The march had been organised by the Northern Ireland Civil Rights Association (NICRA) to protest against internment without trial. Other protesters were injured by shrapnel, rubber bullets, or

batons; two were run down by British Army vehicles; and some were beaten.
