Two major alternatives to in vivo animal testing are in vitro cell culture techniques and in silico computer simulation; however, some claim they are not true alternatives because simulations use data from prior animal experiments and cell cultures often require animal derived products, such as serum or cells. Clinical trial [citation needed] The most common clinical trials evaluate new pharmaceutical products Clinical trials are prospective biomedical or behavioral research studies on human participants designed to answer specific questions about biomedical or behavioral interventions, including new treatments (such as novel vaccines, drugs, dietary choices, dietary supplements, and medical devices) and known interventions that warrant further study and comparison. They are conducted only after they have received health authority/ethics committee approval in the country where approval of the therapy is sought. Clinical trials generate data on dosage, safety and efficacy. application of the scientific method, specifically the experimental step. These authorities are responsible for vetting the risk/benefit ratio of the trial—their approval does not mean the therapy is 'safe' or effective, only that the trial may be conducted 92959793ee
