student drop-out rates. Medication is not recommended to treat test anxiety; instead, standard suggestions include sleep. Test anxiety is a combination of physiological over-arousal, tension and somatic symptoms, along with worry, dread, fear of failure, and catastrophizing, that occur before or during test situations.
