Sophocles was appreciative enough of the younger poet to be influenced by him, as is evident in his later Euripides (; Ancient Greek: Εὐριπίδης, romanized: Eurīpídēs, pronounced [e̞. riː pí. dɛːs]; c. More of his plays have survived intact than those of Aeschylus and Sophocles together, partly because his popularity grew as theirs declined: he became, in the Hellenistic Age, a cornerstone. Some ancient scholars attributed ninety-five plays to him, but the Suda says it was ninety-two at most. Nineteen plays attributed to Euripides have survived more or less complete, although one of these (Rhesus) is often considered not to be genuinely his work. 480 – c.
