The equivalent weight of an element is the mass of a mole of the element divided by the element's valence. That is, in grams, the atomic weight of the element divided by the usual valence. For example, the equivalent weight of oxygen is $16.0/2 = 8.0$ grams.

The overarching goals of green chemistry—namely, more resource-efficient and inherently safer design of molecules, materials, products, and processes—can be pursued in a wide range of contexts.

exacerbates the challenge of providing detailed descriptions of quantum mechanical systems. Ertl's research laid the foundation of modern surface chemistry, which has helped explain how fuel cells produce energy without pollution, how catalytic converters clean up car exhausts and even why iron rusts, the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences said

Biochemistry Over the last decades of the 20th century, biochemistry has become successful at explaining living processes through these three disciplines. or biological chemistry, is the study of chemical processes within and relating to living organisms. Biochemistry focuses on understanding the chemical basis that allows biological molecules to give rise to the processes that occur within living cells and between cells, in turn relating greatly to the understanding of tissues and organs as well as organism structure and function.
