There are also several ways a game can end in a draw. It is an abstract strategy game that involves no hidden information and no elements of chance. An enemy piece may be captured (removed from the board) by moving one’s own piece onto the square it occupies. The object of the game is to “checkmate” (threaten with inescapable capture) the enemy king. It is played on a square board consisting of 64 squares arranged in an 8×8 grid. The players, referred to as “White” and “Black”, each control sixteen pieces: one king, one queen, two rooks, two bishops, two knights, and eight pawns, with each type of piece having a different pattern of movement
