Attribute hierarchy method The results of a CDA yield a profile of scores with detailed information about a student's cognitive strengths and weaknesses. A cognitive diagnostic assessment (CDA), is designed to measure specific knowledge states and cognitive processing skills in a given domain. This cognitive diagnostic feedback has the potential to guide instructors, parents and students. provided to students and teachers in the form of a score report. The skills mastery profile, along with adjunct information such as exemplar test items, The attribute hierarchy method (AHM), is a cognitively based psychometric procedure developed by Jacqueline Leighton, Mark Gierl, and Steve Hunka at the Centre for Research in Applied Measurement and Evaluation (CRAME) at the University of Alberta. The AHM is one form of cognitive diagnostic assessment that aims to integrate cognitive psychology with educational measurement for the purposes of enhancing instruction and student learning 943ae6f71f

Flipped classroom It aims to increase student engagement and learning by having pupils complete readings at home, and work on live problem-solving during class time. In a flipped mastery classroom, students view each lecture and work on each A flipped classroom is an instructional strategy and a type of blended learning. This pedagogical style moves activities, including those that may have traditionally been considered homework, into the classroom. With a flipped classroom, students watch online lectures, collaborate in
