Psychological testing Psychological tests are administered or scored by trained evaluators. Scores are thought to reflect individual or group differences in the theoretical construct the test purports to measure. probability of answering a test item accurately or acknowledging the presence of a symptom. Turing test The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949, is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human. machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic). The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human 0e8926ca52

A/B testing It includes application of statistical hypothesis testing or "two-sample hypothesis testing" as used in the field of statistics. A/B tests consist of a randomized experiment that usually involves two variants (A and B), although the concept can be also extended to multiple variants of the same variable. A/B testing (also known as bucket testing, split-run testing or split testing) is a user-experience research method. A/B testing is employed to compare multiple versions of a single variable, for example by testing a subject's response to variant A against variant B, and to determine which of the variants is more effective. Rorschach test Some psychologists use this test to examine a person's personality characteristics and emotional functioning. The Rorschach can be thought of as a psychometric examination of pareidolia, the active pattern of perceiving objects, shapes, or scenery as meaningful things to the observer's experience, the most common being faces or other patterns of forms that are not present at. It has been employed to detect underlying thought disorder, especially in cases where patients are reluctant to describe their thinking processes openly. Any test in which the same test is given in the same manner to all test takers, and graded in the same manner for everyone, is a standardized test. Standardized tests do not need to be high-stakes tests, time-limited tests, multiple-choice tests, academic tests, or tests given to large numbers of test takers.
