They range from colorless gases like hydrogen to shiny crystals like iodine. Chemically, nonmetals have relatively high electronegativity or usually attract electrons in a chemical bond with another element, and their oxides tend to be acidic. Physically, they are usually lighter (less dense) than elements that form metals and are often poor conductors of heat and electricity
