Foreign relations of Israel Israel is a member of the United Nations (UN) and a number of other international organisations. Morocco agreed to establish diplomatic relations with Israel in exchange for the United States supporting Morocco's claim on Western Sahara. Israel maintains full diplomatic relations with two of its Arab neighbours, Egypt and Jordan, after signing peace treaties in 1979 and 1994 respectively. On the same Foreign relations of Israel refers to diplomatic and trade relations between Israel and other countries around the world. As of 2021, Israel had formal diplomatic relations with 168 countries, while twenty-eight UN member states have either never established, or have broken off diplomatic relations with Israel. In 2020, Israel signed agreements establishing diplomatic relations with three Arab League countries, Bahrain, the United Arab Emirates, and Morocco. Israel has diplomatic ties with 165 of the other 192 UN member states as of 12 December 2020

At the heart of its international diplomacy is a multivector foreign policy, which aims to maintain balanced and diverse relations with all major global powers and regional neighbours. Kazakhstan established a customs union with Russia and Belarus which eventually became the Eurasian Economic Union

Foreign relations of India The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) is the government agency responsible for the conduct of foreign relations of India. With the world's third largest military expenditure, second largest armed force, fourth largest economy by GDP nominal rates and third largest economy in terms of purchasing power parity, India is a prominent regional power and a potential superpower. India had also contributed some India, officially the Republic of India, has full diplomatic relations with 201 states, including Palestine, the Holy See, and Niue. India's solidarity with Egypt over border issues with Sudan, and Sudan's intimate bonds with Pakistan and Bangladesh

Many states and supranational bodies condemned Gaddafi's regime over its attacks on civilian targets within the country.

Virtually all Western countries cut off diplomatic relations with Gaddafi's government over an aerial bombing campaign in February and March, and a number of other countries led by Peru and Botswana did likewise. The regime's use of the
