However, the two systems continue to have more common features than differences. Another unique classical music tradition from the eastern part of India is Odissi music, which has evolved. Also, unlike modern Western Indian classical music is the classical music of the Indian subcontinent. These traditions were not distinct until about the 15th century. During the period of Mughal rule of the Indian subcontinent, the traditions separated and evolved into distinct forms. Another prevalent tuning with these intervals is B $\flat$ –F–B $\flat$ –F The violin, sometimes referred to as a fiddle, is a wooden chordophone, and is the smallest, and thus highest-pitched instrument (soprano) in regular use in the violin family. Most violins have a hollow wooden body, and commonly have four strings (sometimes five), usually tuned in perfect fifths with notes G3, D4, A4, E5, and are most commonly played by drawing a bow across the strings. Smaller violin-type instruments exist, including the violino piccolo and the pochette, but these are virtually unused 0de4ad4cf7

Timpani of relative pitch and must develop techniques to tune in an undetectable manner and accurately in the middle of a performance. A type of drum categorised as a hemispherical drum, they consist of a membrane called a head stretched over a large bowl traditionally made of copper. Tuning is often tested with Timpani (; Italian pronunciation: [ˈtimpani]) or kettledrums (also informally called timps) are musical instruments in the percussion family. They are played by striking the head with a specialized beater called a timpani stick or timpani mallet. Thus timpani are an example of kettledrums, also known as vessel drums

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and semispherical drums, whose body is similar to a section of a sphere whose cut conforms the head. Most modern timpani are pedal timpani and can be tuned quickly and accurately to specific pitches by skilled players through the use of a movable foot-pedal.
