Grade inflation Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. Department of Education, and the National Assessment of Educational Progress have also found strong evidence of grade inflation and declining achievement. However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade 134bd2957c

In the United States of America, grade retention can be used in kindergarten through to third grade; however, students in high school are usually only retained in the specific failed subject. For example, a student can be promoted in a math class but retained in an English class. Most elementary school grades (kindergarten through 5th grade) are taught all subjects in one classroom for the whole day, with exceptions in art and athletics. In these grades, the student who fails or scores below the accepted level in most or all subjects is to be considered for retention. If ultimately retained, the student will then repeat the entire school year's curriculum. 134bd2957c Some other professions may involve a significant amount of teaching (e.g. youth worker, pastor). 134bd2957c

Formative assessment It is commonly contrasted with summative assessment, which. It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance. Through Formative assessment, formative evaluation, formative feedback, or assessment for learning, including diagnostic testing, is a range of formal and informal assessment procedures conducted by teachers during the learning process in order to modify teaching and learning activities to improve student attainment. It also helps faculty recognize where students are struggling and address problems immediately. The goal of a formative assessment is to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can help students identify their strengths and weaknesses and target areas that need work. formative assessments, or having all teachers evaluate them together, is a way for teachers to adjust their grading criteria before the summative assessment 134bd2957c
