Mission-type tactics The subordinate leaders are given planning initiative and freedom of execution: they decide on the methods to achieve the objective independently. In armies which don't, as a whole, embody mission-style tactics, taking the risk of disobeying some orders or Mission-type tactics (German: Auftragstaktik, from Auftrag and Taktik; also known as mission command in the United States and the United Kingdom) is a method of command and delegation where the military commander gives subordinate leaders a clearly defined objective, high-level details such as a timeframe, and the forces needed to accomplish that objective. This may be contrasted with "Befehlstaktik. violate other guidance or received orders. This allows a high degree of flexibility at the operational and tactical levels of command, which allows for faster decision-making on the ground and frees the higher leadership from managing the tactical details to concentrate on the strategic picture 412b4312c9
