Mir The station served as a microgravity research laboratory in which crews conducted experiments in biology, human biology, physics, astronomy, meteorology, and spacecraft systems with a goal of developing technologies required for permanent occupation of space. The tests were to gauge Mir (Russian: Мир, IPA: ['mʲir]; lit. 'peace' or 'world') was a space station operated in low Earth orbit from 1986 to 2001, first by the Soviet Union and later by the Russian Federation. other two accidents concerned testing of the station's TORU manual docking system to manually dock Progress M-33 and Progress M-34. Mir was the first modular space station and was assembled in orbit from 1986 to 1996. It had a greater mass than any previous spacecraft. At the time it was the largest artificial satellite in orbit, succeeded by the International Space Station (ISS) after Mir's orbit decayed 8a93ea2974

Space Race Gagarin became a national hero of the Soviet Union The Space Race (Russian: космическая гонка, romanized: kosmicheskaya gonka, IPA: [kɐs'mʲitɕɪskəjə 'gonkə]) was a 20th-century competition between the Cold War rivals, the United States and the Soviet Union, to achieve superior spaceflight capability. but Gagarin was given an envelope containing the code that would unlock manual control in an emergency. The technological advantage demonstrated by spaceflight achievement was seen as necessary for national security, particularly in regard to intercontinental ballistic missile and satellite reconnaissance capability, but also became part of the cultural symbolism and ideology of the time. It had its origins in the ballistic missile-based nuclear arms race between the two nations following World War II and the onset of the Cold War. The Space Race brought pioneering launches of artificial satellites, robotic landers to the Moon, Venus, and Mars, and 8a93ea2974
