Nonmetal They range from colorless gases like hydrogen to shiny crystals like iodine. Physically, they are usually lighter (less dense) than elements that form metals and are often poor conductors of heat and electricity. Chemically, nonmetals have relatively high electronegativity or usually attract

electrons in a chemical bond with another element, and their oxides tend to be acidic. Drawing on this, in 1864 the "Manual of Metalloids" divided all elements into either metals In the context of the periodic table, a nonmetal is a chemical element that mostly lacks distinctive metallic properties. form negatively charged ions with oxygen in aqueous solutions

Seventeen elements are widely recognized as nonmetals. Additionally, some or all of six borderline elements (metalloids) are sometimes counted as nonmetals.
