The conflict was fought between supporters of the House of York (whose emblem was a white rose) and the House of Lancaster (whose emblem, only by 1485, was a red rose), two rival cadet branches of the royal House of Plantagenet. The conflict resulted in the end of Lancaster's male line in 1471, leaving the Tudor family to inherit, through the female line, the Lancaster claim to the throne b27413b677
