It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance. The goal of a formative assessment is to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can help students identify their strengths and weaknesses and target areas that need work. It is commonly contrasted with summative assessment, which. It also helps faculty recognize where students are struggling and address problems immediately

"I know that snow is white"), in other words facts that can be expressed using declarative sentences, procedural knowledge involves one's ability to do something (e. g. "I know how to change a flat tire"). Procedural knowledge (also known as know-how, knowing-how, and sometimes referred to as practical knowledge, imperative knowledge, or performative knowledge) is the knowledge exercised in the performance of some task. math. A person does not need to be able to verbally articulate their procedural knowledge in order for it to count as knowledge, since procedural knowledge requires only knowing how to correctly perform an action or exercise. Metacognition Metacognition can take many forms, such as reflecting on one's ways of thinking, and knowing when and how oneself and others use particular strategies for problem-solving. There are generally two components of metacognition: (1) cognitive conceptions and (2) a cognitive regulation system. Research has shown that both components of metacognition play key roles in metaconceptual knowledge and learning. The term comes from the root word meta, meaning "beyond", or "on top of". A number of theorists have proposed a common mechanism behind Metacognition is an awareness of one's thought processes and an understanding of the patterns behind them. to review an essay are the same as those that are used to verify an answer to a math question.
