There is the inevitable clash between formal authority and power and those individuals and groups affected. There are jurisdictional disagreements among individuals, departments, and between unions and management. As a result Organizational conflict, or workplace conflict, is a state of discord caused by the actual or perceived opposition of needs, values and interests between people working together. It is easy to see that under the conditions described above, mutual solutions to problems cannot be achieved. There are disputes over how revenues should be divided, how the work should be done, and how long and hard people should work. There are subtler forms of conflict involving rivalries, jealousies, personality clashes, role definitions, and struggles for power and favor.
